NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATE AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST CITY MEASURES MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY CLERK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following measures will be voted on at the Municipal General Election to be held in the City of Culver City and consolidated with the State General Election on **Tuesday, November 8, 2016.**

CULVER CITY SAFE/CLEAN WATER PROTECTION MEASURE. To protect public health/groundwater supplies and prevent toxins and pollutants from contaminating local waterways, creeks and beaches, by improving storm drains/infrastructure to capture/clean urban runoff; preserving open space; and complying with clean water laws, shall Culver City establish a \$99 clean water parcel tax; generating approximately \$2,000,000 annually until ended by voters, requiring independent audits, public oversight, low-income senior citizens discounts and local control of funds?	Yes
Measure: Shall Section 607 and Section 700 of the Charter of the City of Culver City be amended to change the appointing authority and the reporting responsibilities of the Fire Chief and Police	Yes
Measure: Shall Section 602 of the Charter of the City of Culver City be amended to provide for the ineligibility of a person who has resigned from the City Council to run	Yes
for the Office of City Council Member for a period of two years from the date of such resignation? Measure: Shall Section 608 of the Charter of the City of Culver City be amended to authorize the City Council to determine the dates of Regular Meetings of the City	Yes

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Section 11 of City Council Resolution No. 2016-R018, and Section 9280 of the Elections Code, the impartial analyses of said measures prepared by the City Attorney shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk not later than <u>5:30 p.m.</u> Thursday, August 18, 2016.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Section 9282(b) of the Elections Code, any and all direct arguments for and against the measure shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk not later than <u>5:30 p.m. Thursday</u>, August 18, 2016. All arguments shall be accompanied by the information set forth in Section 9283 of the Elections Code. Written argument(s) shall not exceed 300 words in length. City Council has authorized two members of the City Council to prepare and file with the City Clerk written arguments in support of the Culver City Safe/Clean Water Protection Measure; and two different members of the City Council to prepare and file with the City Clerk written arguments in support of each of the above measures amending the Charter of the City of Culver City.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, pursuant to Elections Code Section 9287, in the event more than one argument for or more than one argument against the initiative is submitted to the City Clerk within the time prescribed, the City Clerk must select one of the arguments in favor and one of the arguments against the measures for printing and distribution to the voters. In selecting each of the arguments, the City Clerk must give preference and priority, in the order named, to the arguments of the following:

- The legislative body, or member(s) of the legislative body authorized by that body
- The individual voter, or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of the measures
- · Bona fide associations of citizens; and
- Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measures

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, pursuant to Section 9286 of the Elections Code, that any change to or withdrawal of any ballot argument for or against the above measures must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk not later than <u>5:30 p.m., Thursday, August 18, 2016.</u>

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any impartial analysis or direct arguments filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination during regular office hours in the office of the City Clerk for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. (**August 19, 2016 through August 28, 2016**)

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, pursuant to Section 9285 of the Elections Code, that any written rebuttal argument for or against the above measures shall not exceed 250 words in length and must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk not later than <u>5:30 p.m., Friday, August 26, 2016.</u>

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of Section 9285 of the Elections Code will be available for public examination during regular office hours in the office of the City of Culver City for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. (**August 27, 2016 through September 6, 2016.**)
